The PACC Professional Certification Program sets the standard of excellence for the access and privacy profession in Canada, and is among the first privacy and access-to-information credentials designed to meet the stringent requirements of ISO/IEC Standard 17024, a global benchmark for assessing and certifying personnel.

As the true mark of distinction for access and privacy professionals, colleagues, employers and the public know that only the most well-qualified and experienced succeed in achieving an AAPP, CAPP or MAPP designation.

AAPP — **Associate Access & Privacy Professional** — is the foundation level designation for access and privacy professionals. Achieving an AAPP says you have demonstrated your knowledge and correct understanding of the fundamental processes and terminology as defined in PACC's Common Body of Knowledge.

CAPP — **Chartered Access & Privacy Professional** — is the intermediate level designation, and tells the world that you have demonstrated an intermediate level knowledge of privacy and access, as well as the ability to apply or conduct a wide range of tasks and responsibilities related to data protection, and that you have the necessary skills and experience in the application of that knowledge.

MAPP — **Master Access & Privacy Professional** — is the most senior designation for Access & Privacy Professionals. Attaining an MAPP credential indicates you have demonstrated your expert skills, knowledge and experience in access and privacy practices and processes, including managing access and privacy staff, establishing a group or office, developing and conducting training, and leading an investigation or project team.
