SIX STEPS TO CERTIFICATION

Individuals who meet eligibility requirements and successfully demonstrate qualifying levels of skill, experience and education may qualify for the three-year AAPP, CAPP, or MAPP designation.

- 1. Gain relevant work experience** in three domains: Privacy Domain, Access to Information Domain, and Access and Privacy Management.
- 2. Earn the required education credits** through relevant programs, courses and learning opportunities.
- 3. Pledge to adhere to the Code of Ethical Principles and Professional Conduct**, a mainstay of the profession.
- 4. Gather reference statements** attesting to your access and privacy work experience.
- 5. Agree to comply with the Continuing Education Policy** to stay current with legislative and practice developments, and to qualify for re-certification.
- 6. Submit a completed application for certification and supporting documents** for consideration and evaluation.
